Have you ever played that game in the car with your kids or friends where you let them call out random directions just to see where it would lead you? One person might say, "Turn right!" and another might yell, "U-turn!" and off you'd go, trusting the chaos of the moment. Sometimes their directions came with plenty of notice, making it easy to prepare for the turn. Other times, they came out of nowhere. They were fast and unexpected, almost impossible to follow. The funniest moments were when we found ourselves at a dead end or in a "sus" (suspicious) location. Then came the regrouping, the laughter, and decision time. Do we turn back, or do we get out and explore? Some of the places we ended up were worth pausing to enjoy for a while and others we decided were better left unexplored. But either way, the experience became its own kind of adventure.

Sometimes these random turns gave us a surprise as they reminded us of something from the past or they were like an arrow pointing to what's next. We never quite knew what we were going to get, but before we started, we all made an agreement...trust the process. We wouldn't quit. Whether there was a set destination or just a certain amount of time spent in the game. Either way, it was about trust, commitment, and staying in harmony with one another.

That little car game reminds me of life's own unfolding journey and the role of the internal voice of Spirit or what I call Consciousness. Sometimes we may misinterpret the instructions, or Spirit may lead us to a place simply meant for pausing and remembering before moving forward. If we stay in harmony, honor our commitment, and keep listening, we'll find that we are always being led exactly where we need to be, arriving in perfect divine timing.

It makes me think of the moment when Jesus said, "Follow me." (Matthew 4:19) Those two words sparked countless journeys of faith. The disciples, Mary, and so many others (men and women alike) chose to trust that voice. They didn't know where the next turn would take them, but they followed, believing that the One giving the directions knew the way. And that's the invitation that still echoes in every heart, mind, and soul that's willing to listen, "Trust Me. Stay with Me. We're going somewhere good." Life can be filled with missed turns, wrong turns, and unexpected turns, but you never know when that might just be Spirit saying, "Follow Me!"
