My Cup Overflows, Psalm 23
Easter 4C, May 8, 2022
Theme: Eternal Life

That first cup of coffee in the morning!

Sharp complex flavors cut through what drowsiness is left, after rising from a night of rest. It doesn't matter what kind of night it was, restless, or restful, that sting of caffeine rushes through your blood stream and gives you a push for new life.

Or, at least it does for me.

It starts the day and my morning meditations and prayers.

But the cup King David sings about in his song has much, much deeper meaning. It is the Cup of Blessing. Tradition claims David wrote the words immortalized in what we call the 23rd Psalm.

The Cup of Blessing is the third cup of the Passover Feast. This feast was ancient even by the time David was King of Israel.

Did he write it when he was a shepherd boy?

"He makes me lie down in green pastures; he leads me beside still waters."

Did he write it after he was anointed king?

"He restores my soul. He leads me in right paths for his name's sake."

Did he write it after his son Absolom was killed in battle?

"Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I fear no evil; for you are with me; your rod and your staff— they comfort me."

Could David have written the Psalm after one of his major victories in battle?

"You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows."

Did he write it when Soloman was born?

"Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life."

Did he write it when he was old and near death?

"I shall dwell in the house of the Lord my whole life long."


